

viction thereof, he imprisoned for the same in the County jail for a term not less than ten days. The Act of the General Assembly provides for the re-assessment of real estate, and to correct the records of the County Auditor's office of errors, if any exist, and to furnish a correct and complete return of all taxable property in Richland County. The law also requires the County Anditor to assess all parties who fail to make a return of their real and personal property within the time above noted, with a penalty of 50 per cent. on both. The law in this particular will be rigidly enforced, except in cases of sickness or ab-sence from the County, and all returns will be received and assessments made in accord-ance with law, at the Auditor's effice, in Co-lumbia, S.
