A bale of cotton was sold in Covington, Ga., on Monday, for fifteen cents a pound, which was picked, ginned and packed in the fall of 1863. The rope and bagging was of Confederate manufacture and presented a novel appearance. The owner had been offered forty-two cents per pound for ten bales of cotton of the same crop in 1865, and held it with the expectation of getting fifty cents. One by one the bales were sold at prices much lower than the first offer, until on Monday, the last one was offer, until on Monday, the last one was hauled from the old shed and let go at niteen cents. The staple was beautiful and time only increased its snowy white-ness. At forty-two cents the ten bales of cotton would have brought \$2,000.




