Geneva is in let's. Within the last six months, the city has received three princely bequests, the third and last one having just been made by the Duchess of Galliera, who has presented to the city the grand palace Brignole, with its magnificent library and picture gallery. An annual rent of 50,000 livres, to be spent in beautifying the city, has accompanied the gift. Her husband, the Duke of Galliera, has moreover set 2,000 livres aside for the erection of rent-free buildings for poor families.

It is quite evident that Bismarck and Von Moltke regard another war with France as possible at any time, and are making preparations to meet contingencies. The standing army of France is set down at 471,000, and it is proposed to keep the German army at 401,000 men on a war footing. This is rather an expensive luxury for both countries.

The news about the Indians is conflicting. It is now reported that at Prescott, Arizona, considerable indignation is felt concerning the rumors about the Indian troubles. People there say the Indians at the Verde Reservation already number 1,400, increase daily, and are well supplied.

Mr. Saul Isaac, who has been returned in the Conservative interest for Nottingham, is, according to the *Jewish Chronicle*, the first Jew professing Conservative principles who has been returned to the House of Commons.
