THE POST OFFICE DEPARTMENT.-The community of Spartanburg are much indebted to the Post Office Department at Washington for a kindly interference at Washington for a kindly interference in their behalf, which has saved them from being systematically fleeced. The 1st of January last, when the law requiring the prepayment of newspaper postage went into effect, the postmaster, Dr. Javan Bryant, increased the box rent from \$3 to \$5 per annum. 
