A. F. Kerensky, the man of the hour in Russia, has been given dictatorial powers to bring order out of the chaos resulting from disaffection in the armies and among certain classes of the people. The Russians have been loosing in the battles of the last few days, following the brilliant victories in the campaign inaugurated early in July by Kerensky. He has again hurried to the front, and it is hoped he will again be able to put the soldiers in a fighting mood. The situation in Russia is serious, but by no means hopeless.

The Journal is pleased to note 1425 the absence of ill feelings in the 1002 controversy between Jefferson 1151 and Pageland relative to the 1101 location of the proposed east to west State highway from Chesterfield to Lancaster. ABOUT THE DRAFT

The list of names printed elsewhere is as nearly correct as we have been able to get it, though it is not official and there will doubtless be a few errors. In the main, however, it is correct, and from this list the 164 men from this county will be selected by the county exemption board. Messrs. I. P. Mangum, Walker Duvall and Dr. J. H. Harden constitute the board, and the meetings will be held at the county seat. The lists will be verified, and notices will be mailed to each man who is to appear before the board for examination. These notices will give the date and place for the examination, and seven days will be allowed for filing claims for exemption. These notices will not be mailed until the board meets and canvasses the lists, Thursday or Friday or per haps later. The men will be called in the order the names are printed in this paper. The first name may be called number 2201 one, the second number two, etc. 477 on through the list of five hun dred and fifty nine names given. The first three hundred and twenty-eight will probably be included in the first call, but it is improbable that the county's quota of 164 men will be secured from this number. In that case others will be called until the number is secured. In the opinion of the writer five hundred or more will be required in this call as the per cent in this county of married men with de pendents is high
