SLIPPING SICKNESS.

Thousands of People Have Died of Strange Malady.

Prof. Robert Koch lectured recently in Berlin, Germany, on the "sleeping sickness" which he investigated for several months in equatorial Africa during the year 1905. Emperor William and a distinguished company was present.

The malady, said the professor, had been known on the west coast of Africa since the beginning of the last century, and it had spread to the north shore of the Victoria Nyarza and thence to German Africa. Probably 200,000 persons had died from the disease. He had found whole villages on the shores of Victoria Nyarza to be empty, and the population of some groups of islands had died to the last soul.

The infection was spread from human to human by the sting of a fly the glossina palpalis, somewhat larger than an ordinary fly. The person affected suffered ill health for several days, and then was attacked with fever, became incoherent, the glands were swollen, the patient became emaciated, and eventually was seized with the sleep mania.

Prof. Koch knew of no remedy for this disease, but hoped the infection might be ended by the extermination of the insect, which propagated slowly, by burning the undergrowth at its favorite home. The professor will return to Africa shortly and continue his studies of tropical diseases.

Fatal Shooting in Columbia.

A special dispatch to The News and Courier says: Ed Tully, a molder at the Gibbs Machinery Factory, on lower Gervais street, was shot in the forehead in Fred Sheppard's store, across the street from the Gibbs place, early Thursday night by Jim Only, a tough and brother-in-law of Sheppard, who was shooting at J. T. Boatwright. Tully appears to have been concerned in the affair in no way, being an innocent bystander. Only had fired several times at Boatwright, who ran into the store and took refuge behind the counter. Boatwright was begging for his life at the time Tully was shot. Tully died half an hour after reaching the hospital, without regaining consciousness. Only and Boatwright have both been arrested, but Only had disposed of his weapon before the police arrived. The coroner, police and others, who have been working on the case are puzzled to discover the motive Only had for firing upon Boatwright. The scene of the killing is a particularly tough section of the town and the leading witnesses are interested in keeping silent. The inquest was held Saturday morning. Only terribly slashed up a fireman named Hopper on slight provocation about a year ago.
