

Thousands of People Have Died of Strange Malady.

Prof. Robert Koch lectured recently in Berlin, Germany, on the "sleeping s ckness." which he investigated for several months in quatorial Africa Tully appears to have been concerned during the year 1905. Emperor William and a distinguished company was present.

The malady, said the professor, had been known on the west coast of Africa since the beginning of the last century, and it had spread to the north shore of the Victoria Nyarza and threatened German Africa. Probably 200,000 persons had died from the on the shores of Victoria Nyar za to be empty, and the population of some groups of islands had died to the last

The infection was spread from hu man to human by the sting of a fl the glossina palpalis, somewhat large er than an ordinary five The person aff cted suffered ill health for several days, and then was attacked with fever, became incoherent, the glands were swollen, the patient became en feebled, and eventually was seized

with the sleep mania. Prof. Koch knew of no remedy for this disease, but hoped the infection might be ended by the extermination of the insect, which propagated slow v, by burning the undergrowth at its avorite home. The professor will return to Africa shortly and continue his studies of trophical diseases.
