Bristow's Only Voice to Be Raised Against Him.

Washington, Jan. 19.-The nomination of John Skelton Williams, now assistant secretary of the treasury, to be comptroller of the currency, and as such ex-officio member of the federal reserve bank board, was confirmed by the senate in executive session late to-

The only opposition to the confirmation of Mr. Williams was voiced by Senator Bristow of Kansas and William Alden Smith of Michigan. Senator Bristow reviewed the action of Mr. Williams in depositing funds with the Munsey Trust company when it took over the United States Trust com pany in this city to avert a panic.

Senators Reed, of Missouri, Martin, of Virginia, Mr. Williams' home State, and Chilton of West Virginia praised the ability of the president's nominee for the important post and urged his confirmation.

There was no roll call on the confirmation and the only voice heard against it was that of Senator Bristow. Mr. Williams now becomes a member of the organization committee, now holding hearings in the West to determine on lacations of the federal reserve banks, and the new comptroller will prepare to join his colleagues, Secretaries McAdoo and Houston, as soon as possible.

Since then Sheriff Owings and his deputies have been working quietly on the case, using no coercion whatever in handling the affair.

In Manning the cornerstone of a monument of the Confederate dead was laid with appropriate ceremonies. In many of the Southern States the schools were closed and memorial services were held under the auspices of the veterans and Daughters of the Confederacy. At Mobile, Ala., veterans of the grand army of the republic joined with the Confederates in a joint celebration of the birth of Gen. Lee and Gen. T. J. ("Stonewall") Jackson, the latter's birthday coming on January 21. In Nashville, Tenn., portraits of the Confederate general were presented to a number of schools, and tonight a general memorial meeting was held in one of the churches. In Chattanooga prizes were awarded in all schools for the best essays dealing with the career of Gen Lee and memorial services were held tonight. In Memphis special exercises were held by the Confederate Historical association.

In Texas the day was quietly observed by patriotic societies and in the schools. Arkansas celebrated the day as a legal holiday, all schools, banks and State offices remaining closed. Mississippi's legislature today held a brief session and adjourned as a tribute to Lee. There were no special services.

Georgia's observance of the occasion also was quiet. In Atlanta Confederate veterans gathered at the State capitol, where they united with the Daughters of the Confederacy in paying tribute to the South's great
