Clarendon's Finance Committee.

A Joint Resolution to provide for the investigation of the financial condition of the County of Clarendon and for the payment of the expenses of the same.

SECTION 1. Be it Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of South Carolina, now met and sitting in General Assembly, and by the authority of the same, That S. A. Nettles, Joseph H. Montgomery and Henry L. Reynolds be, and they are hereby, appointed a Committee to investigate the financial condition of Clarendon County, and if in the judgement of said Committee it appear proper, such investigation may be extended retrospectively to the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six.

SECTION 2. That in conducting the investigation hereinafter authorized, said Committee shall have power to examine the books and records of the respective offices of Treasurer, Auditor, School Commissioner and County Commissioners of said County, and if in the judgement of said Committee it appear proper, such investigation may be extended retrospectively to the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six.

SECTION 3. That upon the completion of such investigation, said Committee shall make a full report of the result of its investigations, setting forth all matters coming within the scope of its transactions therein, together with its recommendations, if any, a copy of which said report shall be filed by the Chairman of said Committee in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas for said County, the original being retained by said Chairman.

SECTION 4. That the members of said Committee shall respectively receive for their services on such Commission a per diem of two dollars and fifty cents, to be paid on the warrant of the County Commissioners of said County out of the special tax which may be levied for that purpose: Provided, That such per diem be not allowed for more than forty-five days service.
