Blacklisted Mr. Bass.

The Charleston postoffice has been notified that the department has issued a final order against L. D. Bass, 3422 Centre street; M. R. Hines, 1314 Fifteenth street, and the American Teachers' Agency and the American Civil Service College, all of Washington. Bass is supposed, secured large sums of money by advertising throughout the country the advantages of a course at his college to any one wanting to obtain a place under the civil service. He represented that applicants enrolled on his lists had a fine show of securing a place and he caught many people in the net. He charged \$2 or \$3 for enrolment but as far as known none of his victims ever secured a place, except a woman he employed in his office. Last spring a friend of his was issued a place in the Union Teachers' Agency, conducted by Bass, which friend had a fine employment for teachers. He went out of business temporarily, but as soon as the order was revoked he changed "Union" to "American" and started up again—News and Courier, Sept. 10.
