EXPOSITION. The commission appointed by His Excellency the governor met in Charleston last week.

The commission appointed by His Excellency the governor met in Charleston last week, to perform their duties under the act appropriating \$50,000 for the State exhibit at the exposition.

Under the act Charleston must have raised \$200,000 in subscriptions, and before one dollar of the State's \$50,000 is expended \$100,000 in cash of Charleston's contribution must be in hand.

The exposition is an assured fact, and we cannot urge too strongly the necessity for immediate action in every county in the State.

To make the exposition a credit to South Carolina, and to bring about good results, the people must awake and go into it with a determination to derive a benefit from the \$50,000 appropriated.

The national appropriation for the Charleston exposition failed of passage, and unless there is an extra session we cannot hope for any aid from Congress.

We believe the unfair discrimination towards Charleston will win the sympathy of the Union, and result in a more determined effort to make the exposition a success.

We think when another appropriation is asked for from the National government, the News Courier will take into consideration that South Carolina has other Representatives in Congress besides Senator Tillman and Congressman Latimer.

We do not care whether Governor McSweeney approves or vetoes the bill, we know all of this advice that is being volunteered by the Columbia State and other papers is gratuitous, and we doubt very much if it is appreciated, certainly not to the extent of affecting the governor's decision one way or another.
