The sessions of the Conference were exceedingly interesting and largely attended by the people of Jordan and the region round about.

The reports of the twenty pastors composing the district were encouraging in many respects and the work of the church believed to be progressive.

On Friday morning Bishop Duncan arrived and presided during the balance of the meeting. The sermon on Sabbath morning delivered by him was profoundly impressive and produced great searching of hearts on the part of the congregation. The influence of it will abide.

A most admirable discourse also was delivered before the Conference by Rev. W. A. Pitts, a former pastor of Jordan Circuit, and under whose wise direction the elegant new church edifice was constructed.

The sermon of Rev. G. H. Waddell in the Presbyterian church on Sabbath morning is highly spoken of and was much appreciated.

The preaching throughout the meeting was of a very helpful and edifying character.

The singing was led by our own Asaph, Brother Luke Wells, and it was most heartily participated in by the members of the Conference and the congregation at large. It was an enjoyable feature of the occasion and produced good results. The acoustics of the new church splendidly sustained the voices of the singers, making melody in their hearts and singing with grace unto the Lord.

The entertainment committee did their work excellently well, we must judge from the oft repeated expressions of appreciation on the part of the guests in attendance.

Two promising young men, Samuel O. Cantej and Summerton and P. C. Garretts of Orange, received licenses to preach and the former was recommended to the South Carolina Annual Conference for admission on trial into the itinerancy.

Addresses of superior forcefulness and earnestness were delivered by the representatives of our educational institutions. These brethren were heard gladly and several of our young people expect to attend the colleges next fall.

A collection amounting to \$25 was taken for the Epworth Orphanage.

The usual resolutions setting forth the attitude of the Church and the sentiment of the Conference touching Sabbath Observance, Temperance, etc., were adopted.

Appreciative resolutions were also passed concerning the hospitality dispensed by the congregation which entertained the Conference and the Presbyterian brethren for use of their house of worship.

The body was invited to hold its next session at Pine Grove in the Salem section, at Bishopville, and at Manning. Pine Grove was selected.

A deeply spiritual influence pervaded the meeting from first to last and most delightful seasons of religious profit are reported to have been enjoyed in the homes of the people during the family worship morning and night.
