McLAURIN ON CHINESE BILL.

Opposes New Measure for Exclusion of Mongolians—Would Injure Our Trade.

Washington, April 14. Special.—Senator McLaurin of South Carolina, addressed the Senate this afternoon in opposition to the pending bill for exclusion of the Chinese.

Mr. McLaurin declared that "the bill as it is presented for passage is faulty in conception, faulty in execution, faulty in detail, faulty in fact, faulty in its premises and its conclusions."

Speaking for South Carolina specifically, Senator McLaurin said: "South Carolina demands first of all that this country shall do its duty on a question of honor—that it shall maintain its integrity in the fulfillment of its treaty obligations."

"Now, is it fair play to the people of the South, just as they are beginning to prosper in manufacturing, in agriculture and in other lines?"
