The majority of people either wholly neglect God or render Him a formal worship, which is worse than none at all, for He seeketh those to worship Him who will worship Him in spirit and in truth. Believers are the temples of the Holy Spirit, mansions in which Father, Son and Spirit dwell (John xlv, 17, 23; I Cor. vi, 19, 20), and if we would know the power of God in and through us we must be willing to be undefiled by the world (Ps. exix, 1).
