A Lost Custom. Among the lost customs of merry England is that of the milkmaids' procession. It was a May day observance.

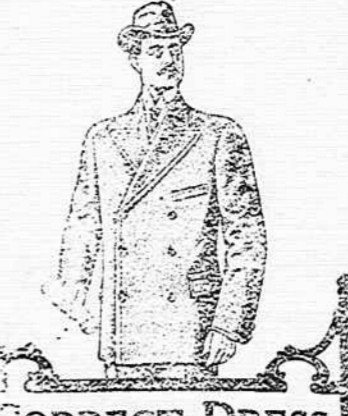
A Green Old Age. A green old age is a phrase often grossly abused. It is a literal translation of Virgil's description of Charon, the ferryman of the nether regions.
