Birthday Fete of the State's Idea of Jamestown Exposition.

The central and prevailing idea of the Jamestown Exposition is that it will serve as a national birthday, the fete of the original forer of the colonies. From Jamestown, the first settlement, spring the many villages of Virginia and the example of the settlements and colonies which line the Atlantic coast from Maine to Spain's possession in Florida. The thirteen original States have not made any general appropriation since the invitation was extended, but it is safe to assume that not one of the commonwealths which was a colony at the time of the great struggle for independence, will fail to be adequately represented at the commemoration of the three hundredth birthday of the nation. The terrace of States which will ornament a shore section of Hampton Roads in 1907, will perhaps be the most remarkable exhibit of this most remarkable exposition. Some of the States have made very large appropriations, others have contributed lesser amounts, but in keeping with their size and wealth. All, however, have agreed on one point, that instead of gigantic Greek temples or Roman palaces, they will erect at the Tercentennial, colonial buildings, keeping pace with the spirit of the undertaking; and in this historical division, they will store historic exhibits, impressive in character and highly instructive. Other States of the Union besides the makers of the nation will participate largely and they will follow the same trend. Ohio, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Missouri and West Virginia will be represented, while the other States whose legislatures convened this year will certainly contribute a fair quota in addition. The exposition company has tried to impress upon the various State commissioners who have visited Norfolk that the exposition will be in a larger sense an educational and historical display and have urged these representatives to make separate and distinct historic exhibits in their buildings. In order to put a premium upon this form of the State's exhibition, a large States' building will be erected, in which the industrial developments of the American commonwealths will have room for the exploitation. From one end to the other of the terrace of States, a student of history will be able to imbibe the lore of each commonwealth and colony from inception; and at the same time to see a collection of the whole. After leaving this terrace, he may visit the History building, where a general collection of works, documents and historic exhibits will be gathered. Our country is young in years but large in events and every State of the Union can point with pride to some great deed performed within its borders, or some great man reared there who has influenced the destinies of the nation. Youth gives us the advantage that our past is not shrouded in a mystery that is impenetrable, and instead of legendary myths, we have true records of the events that have transpired and may draw accurate deductions from positive data. As an illustration of the possibilities of this historic exhibit, Virginia may exploit Jamestown from 1907 to the last decade of the seventeenth century. It may show the beginning of the town; the starting time. The arrival of the first supply; the second period of desertion. The saving of the colony by Lord Delaware. The Commune under the early governors. The birth of free institutions; the first General Assembly, which convened in 1619. The growth under successive governors until the commonwealth, when Virginia enjoyed a freedom unsurpassed in the world's history. The destruction of Jamestown. The beginning of Williamsburg. The splendor under Lord Spotswood; the crossing of the Alleghenies by Spotswood and the Knights of the Golden Horse-Shoe. The cruelties of Dunmore and his expulsion from Williamsburg. The events of the Revolutionary war; those which lead up to the conventions at Williamsburg; the Virginia bill of rights and the military preparations; the events of the war itself; the many battles in Virginia, and the dominating struggle which occurred at Yorktown, not twenty miles from the exposition site. The later events of Virginia history may be represented, bringing the sequence down unbroken through three hundred years. Other States have histories of scarce less antiquity and of great importance. In their buildings, their relics may be told by pictures, maps, documents and other collections instructive to student and patriot. The first commission which visited the exposition site came from "Little Rhody," the State with a small territory and immense name, Rhode Island and the Providence plantations. This commonwealth is represented most ably and if the plans of its commissioners carry full

weight, their State will of itself make an exhibit which no patriotic American or citizen can afford to miss. Of course the other States will hardly do less, and Rhode Island is not selected specially because it will stand single, but it was first to outline its plan, and subsequent visiting commissions have without exception, strongly endorsed it.
