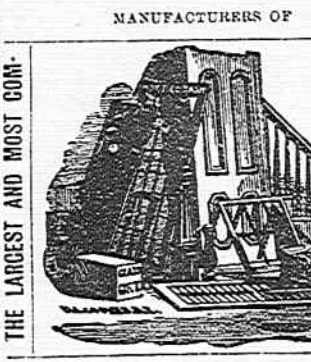

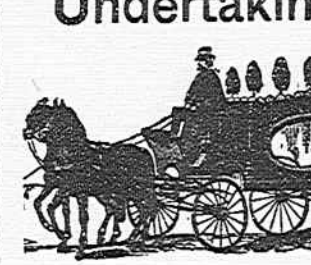

It also provides that if the policy-holder should make ten payments on the 20-payment plan and cease paying premiums the company will pay his estate \$1,000 for every \$1,000 applied for should the insured death occur during the second 10-year period and will not deduct a single premium from the face of the policy. 10th. Should the insured continue to pay his premiums during the second 10-year period and if death should occur during the second 10 years the company will add every premium to the face of the policy that has been paid during this period and pay it in cash plus the face of the policy. 11th.
