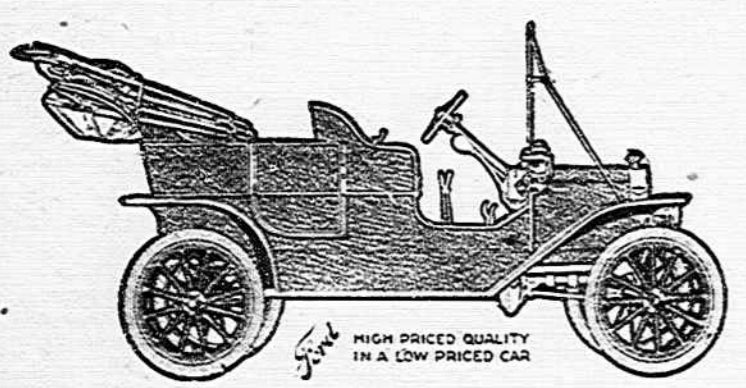

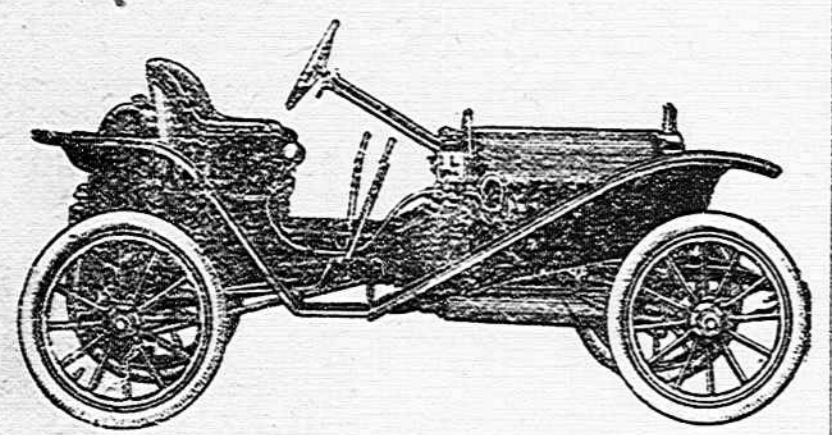

THE ROBIN SLAUGHTER.

From reports which have appeared recently in the daily papers the slaughter of the robins continues without abatement in the south, especially in portions of Tennessee. It seems that in the eastern portion of Rutherford county, in that state, the robins shortly before their migration north congregate by the thousand in the cedar groves, and it has become a custom to form large parties for the purpose of capturing them.

THE FLY CAMPAIGN.

It is a pretty good idea to carry the war on flies into their own territory—namely, out of doors. A big step along this line may be made by putting the accumulations of horse manure in the stable in some screened bin where the flies cannot have access to it, as this is the chief breeding place for the house fly.

WIND AND GASOLINE POWER.

An interesting fact in connection with this state of affairs is that the outward and seemingly thrifty appearance of an animal is no guarantee whatever that it is free from disease.

As a result of a recent order issued by the secretary of the interior there have been withdrawn from entry in Wyoming, Utah and Idaho 2,000,000 acres of land which are underlain with phosphate. He has also recommended to congress that a law be passed which will permit of the mining of this rock phosphate, but only on the condition that none of it be exported.

Breeders of Jersey cattle seem to be dividing into two camps over the question of the type of cow which shall be accepted as a standard by growers of this breed of dairy cattle. Some, the majority, contend that the show ring type—the smaller inbred type—shall be adopted as the standard.

Hairs Upon Horses' Lips.

The fine hairs about the mouth of the horse are organs of touch of extreme delicacy. They serve to a certain extent the same purpose as our finger ends, the whiskers of the cat or the trunk of the elephant. Sensitiveness is due to specially developed endings of nerves in the skin, which are continually sending messages to the brain. The lip hairs of the horse first receive the stimulus, which is communicated to the end organs and so passes on to the brain. They come into play when the horse samples a new article of food. He first smells it and, having so far satisfied himself, touches it delicately with those sensitive hairs. The upper lip moves softly in quick sympathy and confirms the opinion suggested by the hairs. The tongue judges finally as to the fitness of the food. When the horse wishes to drink these hairs assure him that the water is free from foreign matter on the surface, for he drinks from the surface only. They detect the smallest particle of dirt and guide him to the purest place.
