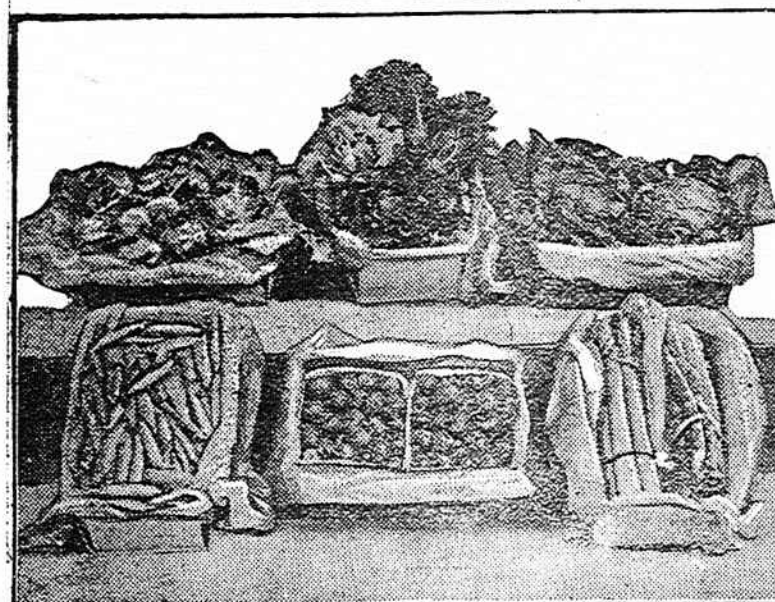

FRESH VEGETABLES ALL THE YEAR ROUND



The season makes no difference, nowadays, in our big cities, where the markets offer all the fresh, green vegetables of midsummer all the year round.

The entire cost of a substantial hotbed need not be over \$12 to \$15, writes C. E. Durst of the Illinois university, and the materials can be used year after year. By its use cabbages, tomatoes, lettuce, cauliflower and other vegetables are secured from two weeks to a month earlier than waiting for the sun to sprout garden seed. Select a site on the side of a hill, with a southern exposure, where good drainage can be secured.

If a hillside is not available, build the hotbed in the shelter of a board fence to protect it from north and west winds. Dig a pit 6x15 feet and two feet deep and fit over it a frame made of boards, using two-inch stuff
