Jewish Flags. The Zionists have adopted a flag made up of a white ground with a blue horizontal stripe on each side, and the shield of David in the center. In reference to the direction from the Book of Numbers, "Every man of the Children of Israel shall pitch by his own standard, with the ensign of their father's house," the Mishnah explains that the emblems and colors corresponded to the 12 precious stones set on the breast plate of the high priest. The colors for the different tribes were as follows: Reuben, red; Simeon, green; Levi, tri-color, white, black and red; Judah, sky blue; Issachar, black; Zebulun, white; Dan, blue; Gad, gray; Naphtali, wine color; Asher, pearl color; Ephraim and Manasseh, jet black; Benjamin, all the above colors combined.

Luminescence of Nitrogen. It has been found that nitrogen, vigorously and spectroscopically pure, acquires a continuous luminescence, during the electric discharge, and therefore this phenomenon can no longer be attributed to the presence of traces of oxygen. In the presence of metallic vapors, such as those of mercury, sodium or potassium, says the Scientific American, the phenomenon is not produced owing to the nitrogen's being attacked by the metallic vapors, forming a combination of the metal with nitrogen. The presence of oxygen, which oxidizes the metallic vapors, hinders their action on the active nitrogen and renders its formation possible.

About Sound Waves. Old-Time Wages. The history of Rumford gives the following account of how farm work was paid among the early settlers of Rumford: Young men who went out to work received \$8 per month, for the six busiest months of the year, which was considered good wages, though an extra hand sometimes earned \$10. Every sick day and every holiday was deducted. It was also specified that no cash should be paid, but settlement to be made in products of the farm. Girls received for services \$5 to 75 cents a week. If the work was spinning wool, the day's work was five skeins of warp or six skeins of filling. Calico was 75 cents a yard.—Lewiston Journal.

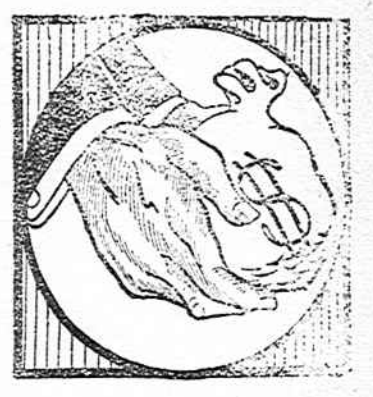
