To Levy and Collect Licenses in The Town of Manning for The Year 1916. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Al-

dermen of the Town of Manning in Counci! A-sembled: Section 1. That every person, firm, company or corporation engaged in any trade, business or profession hereinaf-

ter mentioned within the limits of the town of Manning shall be required on or before the 1st, day of February 1916, to obtain a license to exercise, said trade, business or profession within the limits of the said town; and every person, firm or corporation not now so en-gaged, but expecting to engage in such Express companies or agencies trade, business or profession after the lst day of January of the present year, shall be required to first obtain license to exercise same, all the said license to be fixed according to the schedule and amounts hereinaf er set forth.

Section 2. Upon each and every merchant or any other person, firm company or corporation doing business vithin the limits of the said town of Manning, and for each and every store or place of business within the corporate limits of the said town, except such as are otherwise specifically taxed by this ordinance, the license shall be as

Every firm, company or orporation required by the ordinance of the town of Manning to obtain a license to engage in any trade, business or profession for which a license is required, shall, before the 5th, day of January of each year, register with the town clerk, first his or her name or tyle, and in case of a firm or company, and the place of business; second, the trade, business or profession for which license is required: the place where such trade, business or profession is carried on in the case of a dealer in wares or merchandise, the amount, extent and value of the business carried on, all of which shall be

given under oath! All persons, firms, companies or corporations commencing business on or after the first day of January 1916 shall register as aforesaid. It shall be duty of the town clerk to assess all persons, firms, companies and corporations liable for town licenses under the ordinances of this town, and enter the same in a book to be known as the License Book, giving a classified and complete list of all such persons. firms, companies and corporations who are liable for town license, and the amount of license for which they are iable, which licenses shall be obtained as herein provided, on or before the lst day of February, 1916. License shall be issued by the Clerk and Treas-

urer, who shall keep a record of all license fixed by the ordinances of the town of Manning and assessed by him under authority thereof as aforesaid in the manner prescribed by the laws of the State of South Carolina and the ordinances of the town of Manning.
