Special union services were held in the Baptist church Sunday night to extend to the Rev. J. B. Holly, who has recently come to assume the pastorate of the Baptist church at his place. The Rev. L. B. McCord, of the

Presbyterian church, and senior pastor in point of service in Manning, presided at the meeting and on behalf of himself and his congregation extended a cordial welcome to the new pastor. The Rev. C. B. Smith, pastor of the Methodist church, also extended very happily a hearty welcome, as did Mr. J. K. Breedin, representing the Baptist congregation. The response of Mr. Holly to the several addresses was in full keeping with the spirit and tenor of the welcome tendered. There was a large combined congregation at the meeting. The singing was led by the regular choir of the Baptist congregation.

Mr. Holly has recently come from Georgia, where he has been engaged in the work of the Anti-Saloon League. He succeeds the Rev. E. M. Lightfoot, who left the pastorate here to engage in evangelistic work at Camp Jackson under the auspices of the Baptist Home Mission Board of this State.
