Iquique dispatches indicate that no attempt was made by the Chilean au-thorities to prevent the anti-Peruvian outbreak, although a strong garrison is maintained at that port. Lima is quiet.

Chile Withdraws Consuls Santiago, Chile, Nov. 26.—The Chil-ean Government has decided to with-draw its consuls in Peru in order to evoid untoward incidents which might take place in case of outbreaks in Pera and Chile.
