RECORD NAMES IN WAR RISK FILES

Paris Green and Dinner Bell Helped Win the War

51,000 SMITHS IN SERVICE

A Dozen Napoleon Bonapartes Fought for Uncle Sam Against the Germans.

Washington, Aug. 16.—Paris Green helped win the war. So did a Little Kittie Karr and a Dinner Bell. All of them were in the army, according to file cards in the Bureau of War Risk Insurance. Green lives in Huntington, W. Va., Little Kittie Karr makes his home in Norfolk, Va., and Dinner Bell Page was rung into the service from Urick Mo. Some others who appear in the bureau's files are: Asad Experience Wilson, of Van Hook, N. D.; Mih Gosh, of Chicago; Green Horn, of Statesboro, Ga; Velvet Couch, of Brinkley, Ark; Will Swindle, of Center, Texas; Slaughter Bug, of Osear Tarbin, La; and Pluribus Brown of Perry Go.

Chocolate Candy Clarke, Owen Money, Willie Darling, Great Britton Turner, Wiley Fox Hunter, Green Berry Anderson, Youstus Horrible Riner, George Sleeps From House, Hand-som Pleasant Ayes, Green Hue Jackson, Lloyd George Parliament, Grief Grimes, Precious Grant, Free Office Graves, Huckleberry Shell, Isaac Did-not Butcher and Fine German also are listed.

BLEASE NOW SAYS HE WILL NOT RUN

Says That He Never Had Any Idea of Doing So

Columbia, Aug. 16.—Oespite his statement of several weeks ago that he was a candidate for Congress from the Seventh Congressional District in the general election to be held October 7, Cole L. Blease, former governor of South Carolina, in another statement issued today, said that he is "not now, has never been and never expects to be a candidate for that office." His last statement says that he had a reason for making the announcement that he did, and at present he will let any man suggest to himself what that reason was.

It was intimated in this correspondence last Monday that Mr. Blease would not run in the general election. His friends have stated that he made the statement that he did in order to get the white people to register in his district so that the negro registration, which is only about 2,500 would not be a menace. statement he called on his factional followers to remain away from the primaries so that they could support him in the general election if they so chose.

Since Mr. Blease made his former announcement he has come in for a deal of criticism for his stand, both by newspapers and by individuals. Candidates now making the canvass for the Democratic nomination in the Seventh district have stigmatized Mr. Blease's action as a "bolt" in "in effect an appeal to the negro vote." In reference to these candidates Mr. Blease, in today's statement, says that they should thank him for his announcement. "for they would not have had any speech without it, as they haven't brains enough to make an intelligent argument upon important issues."

"I have never had any desire to be a Congressman, am not now, have never been and never expect to be a candidate for that office.

"I had a purpose in making the announcement that I did on reference to the Seventh district vacancy and may some day say what it was, but at present I will let each man suggest to himself my reason, and don't care a finger snap for the reason, that he may accept.

"My intimate friends knew that I would not be in the race, and I so stated by letter and in person to others; in fact all of my associates

knew that I would not accept that job if offered it unanimously.

I received by letters and personally many assurances of support and some people would be surprised to know how many endorsed my position and the names of men who promised support they being, like myself, tired of such primaries as we have had in recent years.
