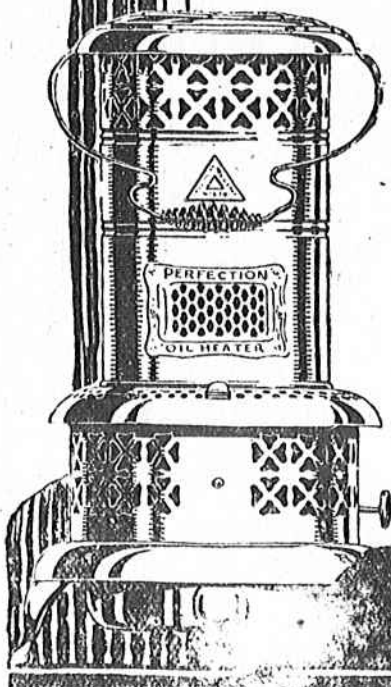

### SUNDAY WORSHIP FOR ROYAL VISITOR

Prince of Wales Goes to Little Wooden Church

#### HEARS BISHOP PREACH

For First Time Capacity Audience Enters Edifice at White Sulphur Springs.

White Sulphur Springs, W. Va., Nov. 15.—The modest little wooden church which nestles among the pine trees on the mountain side here probably for the first time in its existence had a capacity congregation today with the double attraction of a bishop preaching and a royal prince as one of the worshippers. When the Prince

of Wales entered the edifice every seat, with the exception of those reserved for him and his suite, was occupied. Among the trees outside the church the old fashioned buggies of the mountain folk were tied alongside the luxurious limousines of the resort's social colony.

Little groups of the mountaineers and their families gathered near the church to watch the prince as he entered and left the building, but with the courtesy for which they are famous there was no attempt to crowd the royal visitor. From a considerable distance they watched silently the young man whose path in life is so very different from their own as they drove off to their distant farm houses.

The sermon was preached by Bishop William L. Gravatt of West Virginia

who took for his text: "He set his face steadfastly to go to Jerusalem." The substance of the sermon was the necessity of every man, prince or peasant, to have a purpose in life.

At the close of the service the prince waited at the door of the church to greet the bishop who surprised him by telling him that he had been introduced to him once before in London when the British heir was a boy of seven.

She afternoon was devoted to golf and on the links the prince had his second introduction of the day, this time to a British veteran of the war. Private Christopher Nelson of the Lancashire Fusiliers. Private Nelson reminded the prince that he had fought with him at the capture of Guillemont in the great British offensive on the Somme in the summer of

1916.

The prince played his match with Sir Godfrey Thomas, his private secretary, but the main interest was centered on what was announced as the "booby championship" of the United States and Canada, played between General Burstall of the Canadian army, who is attached to the prince's staff, and J. M. Nye, chief special agent of the United States state department. Both claimed to be the worst players on the continent and Nye won.

### WILLIAM O. JENKINS HELD ON CHARGE OF PLANNING ABDUCTION

Mexico City, Mexico, Nov. 16.—(By the Associated Press.)—William O. Jenkins, United States consular agent at Puebla, was placed under arrest Saturday and held under surveillance in his home following charges by officials of Puebla that Jenkins was not abducted by Federico Cordova, the bandit leader, but was in connivance with him, according to information received here last night. The arrest of Jenkins came after twelve peons had sworn to statements before a judge in Puebla, declaring that Jenkins had been seen in company with Cordova, who accomplished his recent abduction from Puebla, under no restraint and in apparent understanding with his alleged captors.

#### Says Charges Absurd.

Washington, Nov. 16.—No word had reached the State Department through official sources tonight concerning the reported arrest of Consular Agent Jenkins at Puebla, on charges of having conspired with the bandit who abducted him. Officials said a report probably will reach here early tomorrow.

The charges against Jenkins were characterized as "absurd," in view of the recent investigation by a judge who declared that the agent was not mixed up in any plot. The off-hand opinion was that it was "a measure of retaliation," following late disclosure, connecting some Mexican authorities with radical propaganda, and in which the name of the Mexican consul general in New York was mentioned.

#### DR. BURTS RESIGNS CHARGE

Columbia, Nov. 16.—The Rev. C. E. Burt, D. D., pastor of the First Baptist church of Columbia the last eight or ten years, tonight announced his resignation to become the head of the general Baptist board of South Carolina, created at the State convention here a few days ago. Dr. Burt will assume his new duties December 1, but will likely continue his pastoral duties until the end of the year. Dr. Purts is one of the most influential leaders of his denomination in the State and his church is reluctantly giving him up. The work of the new board provides a large and useful field, because of the enlarged scope of work made possible by the seventy-five million dollar campaign.
