The President wrote Mr. Glass as follows:

"It was most thoughtful and generous of you to consult my desire in the matter of your selection by Gov. Davis for the Senatorship from Virginia, left vacant by the death of Senator Martin. Of course you must accept the appointment. While your withdrawal from the administration as a cabinet officer is a matter of deep regret to me and to your associates, I feel that your fine ability may again be utilized as a member of the Senate, in advancing the interests of the nation and the administration in that great forum.

"No President has had a more loyal a more devoted, or a more resourceful friend than you have been to me. Your work as chairman of the banking and currency committee of the House of Representatives in connection with the establishment of the federal reserve act and your stout support of the administration at every turn while a member of the House caused us to rely upon you in every emergency.

"While your occupancy of the office of Secretary of the Treasury has been brief, the administration of its affairs under your guidance has moved forward to the highest levels of efficiency and high devotion to the public interest.

"Governor Davis has honored the old State of Virginia by paying tribute to so distinguished a son. We shall watch your career in the Senate with affectionate interest and admiration."

CAR OVERTURNS TWO ARE KILLED

Walterboro, Nov. 17.—Two young men were killed at Cannady's Bridge across the Edisto River, last night when an automobile being driven by Lee Bridge, plunged over the railing and into the river, pinning both beneath the car. This occurred, it is believed, about dark Sunday night, and the car was discovered early this morning. The car was taken out and both bodies recovered. The river was about eight feet deep where the car went down.

TWO HELD ON RIOT CHARGE

Albermarle, N. C., Nov. 17.—Stanley County grand jury in superior court today returned true bills against Marvin L. Ritch, Charlotte lawyer and J. A. Graham of Concord, labor organizer bound over several weeks ago after preliminary hearing on charges of inciting to riot in connection with the labor disturbance at cotton mill here in September, in which Dee Porter, a mill operative was fatally wounded and Sheriff Blalock was shot.

True bills were returned also against about a score of operatives who also were held in connection with alleged rioting. Counsel for Ritch asked for a special venire from which to select a jury. Judge Lane intimated that it would issue an order early tomorrow for a special venire, returnable Wednesday when the trial of Ritch is expected to begin.
