### PROPOSE COTTON BANK FOR STATE

Farmers of South Planning to Warehouse, Market and to Finance Crop.

The formation of a banking and export corporation in South Carolina will be discussed at the annual convention of the South Carolina Cotton association in this city on December 2. The proposed corporation would be similar to one that has already been formed in Georgia, with Governor Dorsey as its head, and with a capital of \$2,500,000.

Many other matters of importance will be discussed at the meeting, says a statement issued by J. Skottowe Wannamaker president of the association yesterday. The meeting will be held at Craven hall and will be called to order at 10 o'clock, a. m.

"Some of the best speakers of the country," said Mr. Wannamaker "will address the meeting on questions of vital importance to the South; among those to speak are Col. Harvie Jordan one of the foremost experts on cotton in the South. He has made a life study of the question and visited every cotton consuming country in the world. Col. Thomas J. Shackelford, a prominent lawyer and farmer of Georgia, will also speak. Col. Shackelford is giving untiringly of his time and services to the work of the association, realizing the tremendous benefit that it will bring to the entire South. D. Shuford Murph, head of the federal warehouse system, Governor Bickett of North Carolina, Governor Cooper of South Carolina, J. S. Wannamaker, president of the association and others will be among the speakers for the occasion.

The first order of business will be the permanent organization of the association, the election of officers, including president, first and second vice presidents, secretary and treasurer, board of directors of the national association, and executive committee.

"This meeting is for the specific purpose of transacting concrete business and there is no question but that matters that will effect the policy of the state, not only for today but for the future will be put into effect and force. While the South Carolina warehouse act has served a great purpose, still to meet present conditions it is absolutely necessary to make certain changes concerning the warehousing of cotton, it being realized that unless this is done the warehouse system

market and finance its own cotton. The Banking and Export corporation will receive the heartiest support and cooperation and the farmers, merchants, bankers, business and professional men have declared wholeheartedly for it. Leading bankers throughout the South to whom these plans have been submitted are supporting it and urging the speedy completion of the necessary corporations for carrying the plan into effect. A similar organization has already been formed in Georgia with a capital of \$2,500,000. There is no question but that one will be established in every state in the cotton belt, thus completing the chain throughout the length and breadth of the cotton belt.

"As a result of all this work there is no question but that cotton will never again sell below the cost of production, that there will be a tremendous saving in the uneconomic manner in which cotton has been handled heretofore.

"Reports received at headquarters show that this will probably be the most largely attended meeting ever held in the state. The various counties are showing considerable rivalry in working up their delegations in an effort to lead the list in representation."
