Only a part of the money necessary was made available from the State Treasury, the plan being for the people of the State by voluntar ysubscription to supplement the one hundred thousand dollars provided for by the General Assembly. Upon a moment's reflection the reason for this will be apparent to you. Had all the money needed for the memorial been raised by taxation, the structure would have lost some of its valuable characteristics, for taxation is highly unpersonal, and largely inexpressive of any particular wish on the part of the tax payer as to the purposes for which the money is to be expended.

"Six months or more ago, the campaign for popular subscriptions was announced, four hundred thousand dollars being the sum agreed upon. Approximately one hundred thousand dollars has now been subscribed. For various reasons the campaign was not pushed to a speedy termination. All of us had just experienced numerous other campaigns; we were resting too, from the fatigue of high pressure incident to the War and necessary for its conduct. It is, however, not necessary for me to elaborate on this phase of the situation.


