

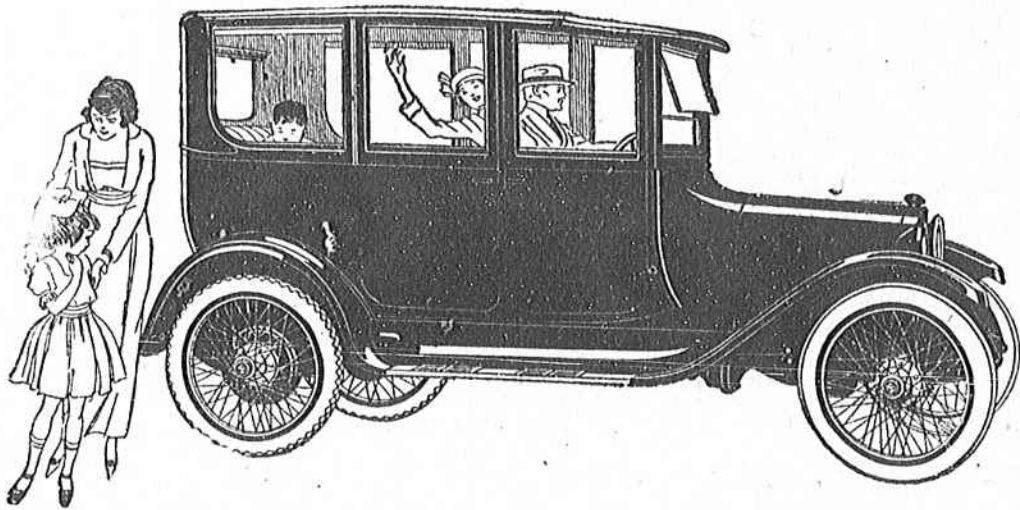

DEVELOPMENT WORK CREATES INTEREST

South Carolina Board Receives Mass of Inquiries.

OFFERS OF COOPERATION

Organization, Purpose and Method of Board's Work Is Outlined.

Columbia, May 23.—Announcement that the South Carolina Development Board is about to undertake an expansion campaign in order to equip itself for larger service to the State, has brought to the headquarters in Columbia a mass of inquiries and many offers of cooperation.

The question which are being asked are mainly along two lines: What is the South Carolina Development Board and, how is or will it be organized? Answers to these questions were given Saturday by officials of the board.

In particular it was pointed out that this organization is thoroughly Democratic, that it is representative of every section of the State, that it is not designed to serve any one or any

group of interests. Attention was also directed to the fact that this is not a brand new movement, but one which has been performing an increasing service in the State for more than a year.

Improvement Sought.

"The development board seeks to improve an existing piece of machinery for an important service to the State as a whole," it was said at the campaign headquarters. "Many citizens are well acquainted with the achievements already placed to the credit of the organization. Many others are aware that through like organizations other States have made tremendous advances.

"In order to enable the South Carolina board to do big, constructive things, such as the California Development Board and those in some other Western States have done, it is realized that it must be adequately financed and its influence increased by an expansion of its individual membership. To realize the possibilities of the enlarged South Carolina Development Board, it is only necessary to examine the plan of organization which is proposed."

Under the direction of members of the State campaign executive committee,

the following tentative outline of the plan for the reorganization and management of the existing South Carolina Development Board has been prepared, and is published today for the first time:

Purpose—I.

The South Carolina Development Board is organized to promote the general welfare of the people of South Carolina; to organize public sentiment in favor of definite projects for the development and full utilization of the State's resources, and to coordinate the influence and strength of all professional, commercial, industrial and agricultural interests in support of a comprehensive program of important state-wide work; thus effecting a partnership which will unite the people of South Carolina in a common purpose—that of adding to the health, happiness and prosperity of the State, the South and the nation.

Membership—II.

Every white resident, business partnership or corporation subscribing to the aims and purposes of the board shall be eligible for membership therein.

Organization—III.

The members of the board resident in each county shall constitute a county

council, the sole function of which council shall be to elect representatives upon the board of control, and to pass upon proposed policies and activities. As the South Carolina Development Board is essentially a State organization, concerned only with projects of state-wide scope and importance, it is expressly provided that the county councils shall exercise no local functions. The councils shall meet annually in October and shall organize by electing a chairman and secretary, who will serve for the ensuing year. Special meetings of the county councils will be called from time to time for the consideration of referenda and whenever vacancies occur among their representatives on the board of control that require to be filled.

The board of control shall be composed of representatives selected from each county in the State. The basis of representation and method of selection shall be as follows:

One representative shall be designated by each local chamber of commerce board of trade and agricultural association for each 200 members, or fraction thereof, of such local organizations. Also, the county council shall at their annual meeting elect one representative, and other additional representatives upon the basis of one for each \$20,000 after the first \$1,000 subscribed from such county for the support of the State organization.

The board of control shall meet annually in the month of November, at the call of the president and at such annual meeting shall elect members of the board of directors and formulate a program of work for the ensuing year. Such program as thus tentatively formulated, shall subsequently be submitted by the board of directors to the county councils by referendum for ratification or rejection, plank by plank.

The program of work as thus formulated will not be considered as exclusive; but may be supplemented from time to time during the year by additional planks initiated by the board of directors and ratified upon reference to the respective county councils.

The full powers of management of the South Carolina Development Board shall be vested in a board of thirty-six directors: "One each to be appointed by the Governor, the South Carolina division, American Cotton Association; the South Carolina division of the American Legion, the South Carolina Bankers' Association, the Chamber of Commerce of South Carolina, the South Carolina Like Stock Association, the South Carolina Press Association and the South Carolina Cotton Manufacturers' Association. The remaining twenty-eight shall be elected as follows:

The members of the board of control from each of the seven congressional districts shall elect four residents of their respective districts to the board of directors.



The directors thus elected shall serve for two years, except that at the election held in 1920, two in each congressional district shall be chosen for a two-year term, and two for one year and, thereafter two shall be annually elected from each congressional district. The board of directors shall organize each year by the election from among their number of a president and two vice presidents, and from the membership at large of a treasurer. The board shall also employ an executive manager and authorize the necessary administrative assistants, the latter to be employed by the executive manager subject to the approval of the board. The officers thus elected by the board of directors shall be the officers

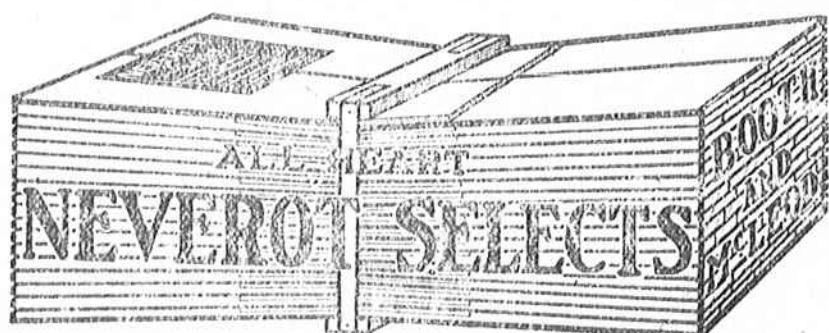
