WARREN SHOULD BE ELECTED

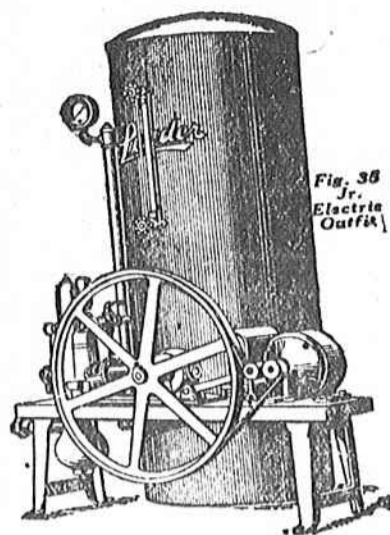

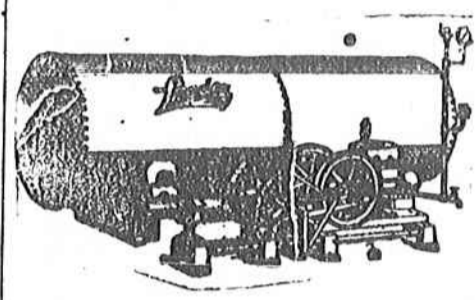
