SAYS PRODUCTION WILL BE REDUCED

Control of Cotton Crop Discussed by Wannamaker

FOLLOW MOSES' LEAD

Tells Manufacturers Many Growers Favor Limitation for Five Consecutive Years.

The American Cotton association yesterday made public a statement issued by J. Skottowe Wannamaker, president, which it announced that it had telegraphed and cabled to many, diverse lines of the cotton industry, especially the leading manufacturers abroad, who have requested definite information concerning the outlook for the production of cotton for the ensuing years, the attitude of the holders of American cotton for cotton now on hand, for which they can get only about one-third the cost of production, and the outlook for the coming crop.

The statement follows: "The cotton producers of America have positively decided to be guided by the wisdom of Moses, who gained great success by limiting production. The lands of Egypt under mandate laid idle every seventh year. The inroads of the boll weevil now covering 77 per cent. of the cotton belt bring to every line of the cotton industry a national and international problem. Its ravages not only enormously reduce cotton production, but fearfully increase the hazard and expense of production.

"A referendum vote submitted to the cotton producers of the 14 cotton growing states on: First, total elimination of the cotton crop for the year 1922, and if necessary every other year, for the purpose of fighting the inroads of the boll weevil; second, limitation of production for five consecutive years, planting only one-fourth of the cultivated lands in cotton with a view of producing for the year 1922 not in excess of 6,000,000 bales of cotton; and third, no reduction in cotton production, shows upon tabulation that the cotton producer realizes the predicament in which he has been placed as a result of the fearful deflation in prices and as a result of the ravages of the boll weevil. The result of this vote will be announced on September 1.

Producers Now in Control

"The producers now absolutely control the production of cotton, so that the production will be based upon the result of this referendum vote. Of the thousands of votes tabulated up to date not a single solitary vote has been received in favor of no reduction. An enormous vote has been received from every section of the cotton belt in favor of a total elimination of the cotton crop by legislation under the bureau of entomology. Limitation of production for five consecutive years as outlined above on votes tabulated to date, however, is leading by hundreds of thousands and indications point to the adoption of this plan.

"I urge that every line of the cotton consuming world be guided by the wisdom of Joseph and secure their material not only for the present but for future wants. The fact that the agricultural organizations of America, representing every line of agriculture, have unanimously adopted our plans for limitation of production to such a point that the product will absolutely assure to the producer a profitable price, a price sufficient to enable him to operate and discharge the debts enforced upon him by the deflation policy, and the fact that the agricultural interests have agreed to meet with us in a congress at Washington for the purpose of devising plans nationwide for securing necessary relief to agricultural conditions, are proof positive that America is **face** to face with the greatest change in its agricultural and commercial life that has come to pass within the last century.

As to Government Report

"The condition report which will be issued by the government on September 1 will bring convincing proof of the limitation of production by limitation in acreage, and also limitation in production by the fearful ravages of the boll weevil, thus making an enormous increase in the hazard and cost of production.

"Keep in mind the fact that in the so-called carry over there is an

enormous amount of unspinnable cotton. The spinnable cotton added to the growing crop should impress upon any one guided by common sense the importance of adopting the course used by Joseph.

"The cotton consuming world is facing limitation of production. The producer is in control and will not longer impoverish himself by producing. He will only produce to such an extent that it will assure him of prosperity and guarantee him against adversity."

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IN SOUTH CAROLINA

Washington, D. C., Aug. 29.—According to the census of 1920 there are 315,069 children 7 to 13 years of age in the state of South Carolina and of this number 274,429 or 87.1 per cent were reported as attending school. In 1910 the percentage attending school was 67.6 thus indicating a decided improvement as regards school attendance between 1910 and 1920. Of the children 14 and 15 years of age in 1920, 78.0 per cent were attending school and of those 16 and 17 years of age 49.2 per cent.

Of the white children 7 to 13 years years of age 78.0 per cent were attending school in 1910 and 93.0 per cent in 1920. For colored children of the same age the percentage in the same interval increased from 60.4 to 82.3.

The percentage of children attending schools was considerably larger in the cities than in the country districts, the percentage for children in the urban population 7 to 13 years of age being 92.3 while in the rural population it was 86.3. "Urban" according to the census definition includes all towns or cities and other incorporated places of 2,500 population or more.

HUNDRED BALES SOLD

Sumter, Aug. 29.—J. F. Bland, a large planter of Mayesville, sold 100 bales of cotton here at 15 cents round. The cotton was purchased by T. G. Bultman, who says the price paid today was five cents above that obtaining two weeks ago.

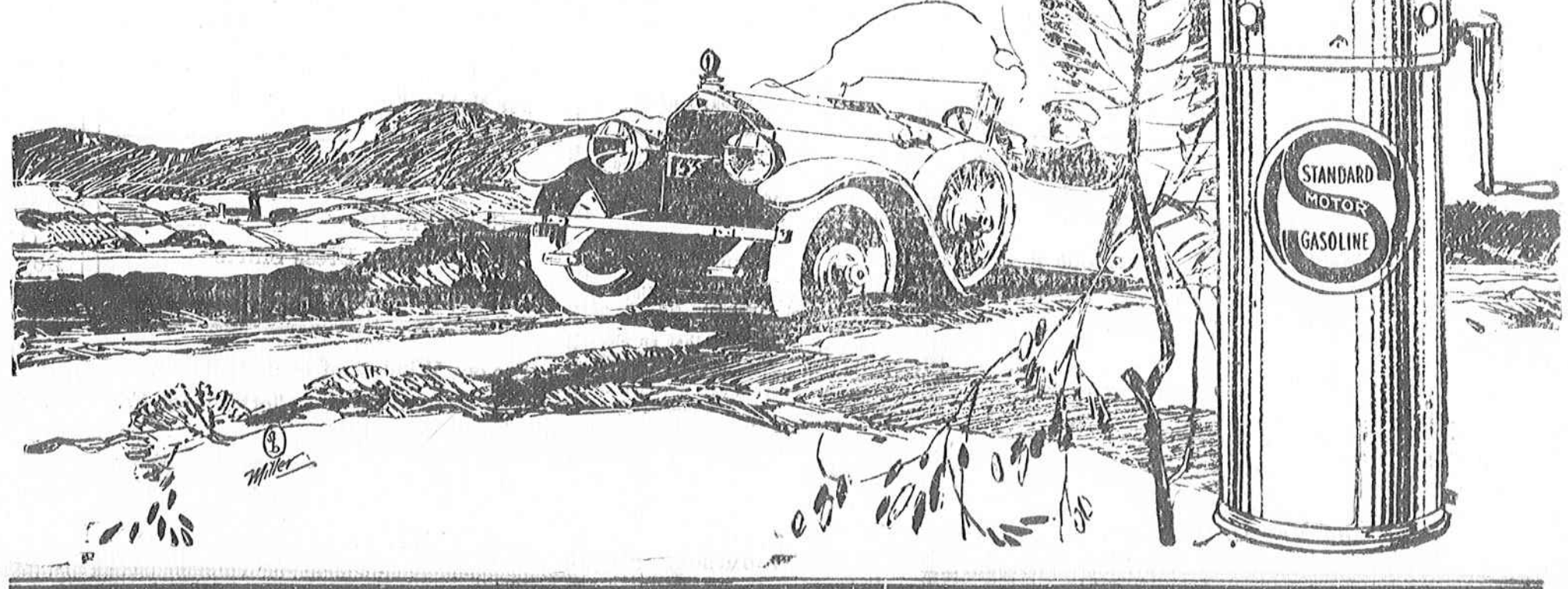
