### Fourth Class Postmastership Examination.

The United States Civil Service Commission has announced an examination to be held at Marion, S. C., on August 24, 1918 as a result of which it is expected to make certification to fill a contemplated vacancy in the position of fourth class postmaster at Lake View, S. C., and other vacancies as they may occur at that office unless shall be decided in the interests of the service to fill the vacancy by reinstatement. The compensation of the postmaster at this office was \$572 for the last official year.

Applicants must have reached their twenty first birthday on the date of the examination, with the exception that in state where women are declared by statute to be of full age for all purposes at eighteen years, women eighteen years of age on the date of the examination will be admitted.

Applicants must reside within the territory supplied by the post office for which the examination is announced.

The examination is open to all citizens of the United States who can comply with the requirements.

Application blanks, form 1753, and full information concerning the requirements of the examination can be secured from the postmaster Commission, Washington, D. C.

Applications should be properly executed and filed with the Commission at Washington, D. C., at the earliest practicable date.
