### BATTLE FOR LIFE WON BY SAILORS

Nine Men Finally Reach Land.

Wilmington, N. C., May 3.—A thrilling tale of shipwreck and subsequent battle for life in open boats was recited today by nine members of the crew of the American steam tug Admiral, which went down 22 miles off Topsail inlet early Saturday morning. These nine men came to Wilmington by train after having been picked up by fisher men off Topsail and taken to Edgemoor.

The men continued their journey tonight for their home station at Philadelphia. According to the master of the Admiral, the crew battled for hours after the ship had been put out of commission being finally forced to take to the life boats. The vessel went down five minutes after the last boat had pushed off. One of the boats was dashed to pieces in attempting to make a landing.

The Admiral, a sea going tug of 89 gross tons, left Philadelphia on April 24 for San Domingo, where she was to have been turned over to Juan Castro and her registry changed. She put in at Norfolk and then proceeded through the inland waterway passing out over the Beaufort battery early Sunday. After reaching the open sea the little craft ran into a stiff south-west wind with rolling seas.

The steam pipe leading to the whistle was broken and all the steam in the boilers escaped.

Her engines dead the little ship rocked at the mercy of the waves, until her seams cracked and she began to fill with water.

Captain Day then ordered his men into the life boats. Five minutes later the Admiral turned stern into the air and sank beneath the waves.




