Although the United States is the Largest Contributor to World Recovery, Canada Has Given More. Per Capita

With the war over, and recovery of war crippling this unhappy state, the Canadian Government has been forced to...

The case of Canada is a good example. The hard work done and the accomplishments achieved by the people of the Dominion have been completely unjustly...

And yet the economy of Canada is as clearly a remarkable success story of the United States that would America, particularly business men, to glance at Canadian statistics.

Canada is not a poor country. Here it is as rich as the United States, and its per capita income is 30 per cent higher than that of the United States.

Canada has given six billion dollars to European and Asiatic countries. Last year it gave three and one-half billion to Europe and one billion to Asia.

To arrive at comparable figures for the United States, one must consider lend-lease and loans and trade credits. The net contribution to Europe would have to be multiplied about five times.
