The game and fish commission bill vas passed by the S. C. house of representatives on March 2. That bill is designed to divorce politics from ame administration. Passage of the bill will not be a "cure all" for wildlife; but it will heal many ills.

In addition to eliminating political administration it will require that all of the sportsmen's dollars (license lees) and other revenues derived present only 55 per cent of license fees are retained by the game and osh department. The other 45 goes to other causes, which in no way help game or fish. The fate of wildlife in South Caro-






