1,666 Persons Drawing Welfare Aid In County

Special to The Chronicle. Columbia, March 23.—A total of \$7,410,278 has been expended in the counties of the state since the first of the fiscal year by the state department of public welfare, as of the first of February, according to a report issued this week by Arthur B. Rivers, department director. The total spent in Laurens county during the first seven months of the present fiscal year is \$262,201, of which \$216,648 was expended for old age assistance, \$4,367 for aid to the blind, \$31,170 for aid to dependent children, and \$11,014 for general assistance.

At the first of February there were 1,666 public assistance cases under care of the department in Laurens county, of the statewide total of 48,574 cases. The largest group of Laurens county cases was old age assistance, of which there were 1,363. Also under care in the county were 26 cases of aid to the blind, 156 cases of aid to dependent children, and 121 general assistance cases.

Of the \$42,017 expended during the month in Laurens county, 82 per cent was used for old age assistance, two per cent for aid to the blind, 11 per cent for aid to dependent children, and five per cent for general assistance.

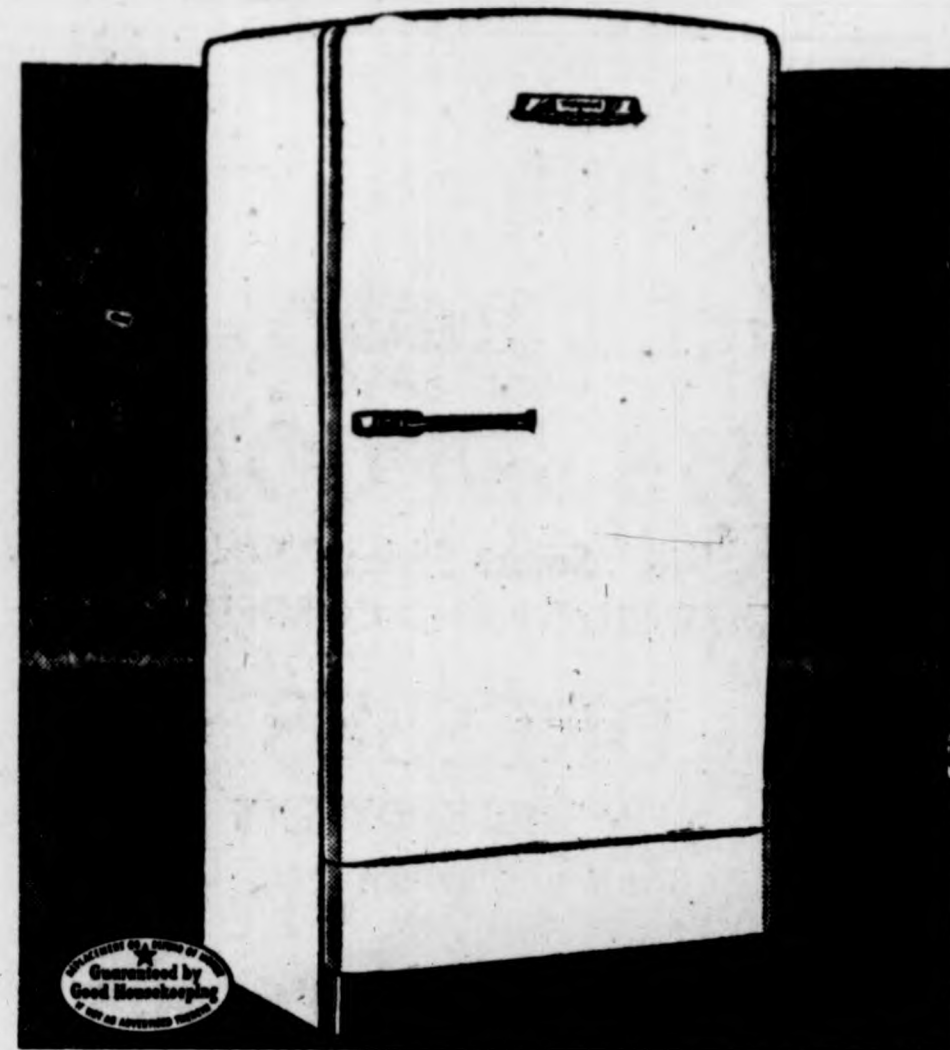
