

PC Alumni Assn. Elects New Officers

New officers and directors have been elected to head the affairs of the Presbyterian College Alumni Association. Public Relations and Alumni Director Ben Hay Hammet announced today.

They were named by mail ballot distributed last month to all alumni. Terms of office begin this year.
