About Your Social Security

Is your employer reporting your social security correctly? Your social security protection under the law depends upon this.

Earnings of workers are credited from reports of their employers; and most of them faithfully report these earnings year after year. Some, such as household employers and farmers who were covered only recently, may not realize their responsibility, and their employees, in particular, should make sure they are protected.

Postcard forms for checking your individual account with social security are available at all district offices and should be used at least every three years by all workers.

If statements returned by social security reveal that earnings are not posted to your record, steps will be taken to correct the omission and insure proper reporting by your employers.

Most people need many years of social security credit to qualify for benefits. It's your social security; make sure you are protected.

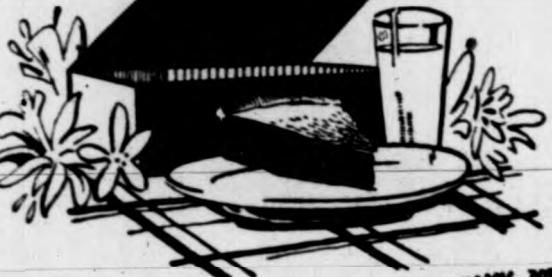
