Use Fresh, Tender Vegetables For Canning, Freezing

Clemson — Capture the fresh goodness of tender garden vegetables by canning or freezing the surplus from your garden. It'll mean future good eating with little bother, according to Miss Margaret Martin, Clemson extension food production and conservation specialist. Whether canning or freezing, select only fresh, young, tender

vegetables. The fresher the vegetables and the quicker they are put into the jar or package the better the canned or frozen product will be. If you buy the vegetables, get them from local gardens. The two methods recommended for canning, according to Miss Martin, are the boiling water bath and the steam pressure canner.
