County Agent Outz figures Laurens County has more registered beef cattle than any other county in the state. And they are doing something very definite about improving them. Their performance testing program is underway with over a thousand cows. This was made possible by the Exchange Club and local farmers buying the necessary portable scales. These are in charge of Assistant County Agent H. L. Eason who supervises the weighings and recerd keeping. The poorer animals were weeded out. A cow must raise a good calf fast to stay in the herds. 
