PC Choir Begins Current Season

The 30-voiced Presbyterian College robed choir opened its 1960-61 concert season with performances at Georgetown, Elizabethtown, N. C., and Ocean Drive this Sunday and Monday.

Programs of sacred music and worship were scheduled for the Georgetown Presbyterian Church on Sunday morning, the Elizabethtown Presbyterian Church that evening and the Ocean Drive First Presbyterian Church on Monday night.

The widely acclaimed choir, under the direction of Conductor Edouard Patte, presented a series of choral pieces and Bible readings developing the theme "The Conquering Church." Selections include sacred classical numbers by Rachmaninoff, Handel, Bach and Grieg as well as Negro spirituals.

Dr. Patte, who begins his 14th season as conductor, selected his current theme to tie in with the 100th anniversary of the Presbyterian Church U.S. His program is divided into six sections which outline "The Founding of the Church," "The Nature of the Church," "The Message of the Church," "The Sacraments of the Church," "The Mission of the Church," and "The Church Triumphant."

Student singers composing the 30 voices of the traveling choir, which will give 26 church performances in six states during the 1960-61 season, were chosen from a larger organization of 42 making up the chapel choir. This latter group performs weekly at campus chapel exercises.
