EDITORIAL

It is believed that it will be for the Government to purchase gold and silver bullion, and instead of sending it to the mint, to have it placed in the hands of the people, and issue paper money on the same terms as the gold and silver, and pay for it with Treasury notes, just as we are doing now in the case of silver. This would preserve the parity between the gold and silver.

The short extract from Senator Sherman's speech on the silver question, shows that he realizes the value of the gold and silver, and that he is in favor of the limited issue of government notes at the rate of one dollar for 70 cents worth of silver, attempting thereby to raise it 20 per cent above its market value.

But for the wretched independent movements two years ago we would not have had the detestable venom injected into the bosom of the Democracy of this State, which is now corroding its vitals, and nearly destroying party discipline. Had opposition ceased after Tillman's nomination the strife of the campaign would have been forgotten and we could be united to-day. As it is we have the prospect of a bitter contest, and danger of a permanent division.

Tillman said at Florence, four years ago, when fighting for the "gold rule," "I will show the knaves." How true an estimate of these summer affairs is the echo in after the battle and begin making the deal easy. It is not intended hereby to reflect on those converts who recognizing in the Governor a faithful and efficient Executive, have withdrawn opposition or given him their support, with all any axe to grind.

He would want the other fellow to be elected.

SCHROCK vs. FLOYD.

Now Who is Right?—Mr. Floyd Says that He is, and Mr. Schrock Says Not.—Your Read Both Sides and Take Your Choice.

[From the News & Courier, 30th.]

As a matter of justice I ask a limited space in your columns to make a simple statement of facts, in defense of myself, as to the charge of bad faith that your correspondent (in a special) from Camden, bearing date 21st inst., so industriously seeks to fasten upon me. I deny positively that there was any agreement or understanding, partly or complete, between Mr. Schrock and myself that I should aid and assist in any way whatsoever his interests as a candidate for the National Democratic Convention from the 5th district.

I assert positively that I had not seen Mr. Schrock for near a month prior to the meeting of the State Convention, and nearly two weeks before the meeting of our county convention, at which time Mr. Schrock knew that I would not be a delegate to the county convention, and of course he didn't know that he would be a delegate to the State Convention. I further assert positively that the only correspondence between us during the month in question was a letter from him on May 11, asking me to act as a delegate to the State Convention in his stead, and which letter contained neither a hint nor a word as to his candidacy. I have the letter. And another of 17th May, handed me on the train, while en route to meet the State Convention, and which contained the first information I had from Mr. Schrock that he was a candidate for the position in question and that he desired my help.

The reference made to letters received by Mr. Schrock from friends at the Convention, by which, apparently, the inference is sought to be drawn that foul and unfair means were employed by me or more to defeat his plans and purposes are absolutely incorrect. I submit as fact, and confidently appeal to every gentleman of the 5th district, that I had no communication with Mr. Schrock, and especially to our county delegation, to hear me out, and which I highly appreciate, was not the result of any political trickery, or even conspicuous electioneering, or even in those days of grab and fight for office.

[After the above was put in print Mr. Floyd sent the following communication to The Chronicle.]

EDITORIAL CHRONICLE.—Your reprint (by request) of an article taken from The State in which the author by consent and endorsement of Mr. Schrock, would make it appear to the people of Kershaw that I had acted in bad faith to wards Mr. Schrock, by disregarding a promise to see that Mr. Schrock was nominated for the position of delegate from the 5th Cong. Dist. to the National Democratic Convention, forces me to lay bare to public scrutiny and unvarnished statement of the whole matter—as follows: On the 23rd of April I saw Mr. Schrock in person at which time we had several conversations upon political topics.

Mr. Schrock on this occasion was made aware of the fact that I was not a delegate from my club to the county convention, he also knew that that the county convention had not met and although a delegate elect himself to the county convention, could not by any possible means know to a certainty that he would be elected a delegate to the State Convention. Therefore not knowing that he would be a member of the State Convention, and the ten fold greater improbability of my being, as events indicated, it was absurd, under the situation, even to entertain the idea that I could possibly be present at the State Convention to see that he was nominated. After the above date and interview, in which the question at issue, was never mentioned, I did not see Mr. Schrock again until the 27th of May and being absent from the State until the 13th of May, did not hear from him, by letter or otherwise, until the 14th of May, the day after I returned home. The following is a copy of the letter which speaks for itself:

Camden, S. C., May 14, 1892. J. W. FLOYD, Esq., Liberty Hill, S. C. Dear J. W. FLOYD: As Mr. Man will not be at home on the 15th it will be impossible for me to go to Columbia. The delegates have made up their minds to go to Columbia and I would like for you to represent me. If you care to do so, drop me a line by Monday's mail. If I don't hear from you then, I shall consider that you don't want the job and will appoint some one else. Yours truly, W. A. SCHROCK.

Not wishing to engage in a personal and acrimonious discussion of the kind so common and tasteful to many writers of the day, I have decided to make no comments,
