

The landslide in favor of Roosevelt last Tuesday was hardly expected and can scarcely be accounted for. The Columbia State sums up the situation as follows:

School Tuition.

Assistant Attorney General Townsend has given out the following important opinion as to the charging of tuition fees by school trustees.

In reference to the right of school trustees to charge tuition fees of scholars from outside of the district, they may charge such fees except where these persons attending from outside the district do so under the direction of the board of trustees of the district in which they reside. Section 1214 of the school law of this State provides:

"When it shall so happen that persons are so situated as to be better accommodated at the school of an adjoining school district, whether special or otherwise, the board of trustees of the school district in which such persons reside may transfer such persons for education to the school district in which such school is located; and the trustees of the school district in which the school is located shall receive such persons into the school as though they resided within the district."

No fees can be charged persons so transferred, but boards of trustees are compelled to receive such persons freely in the same manner as though they resided within your school district.

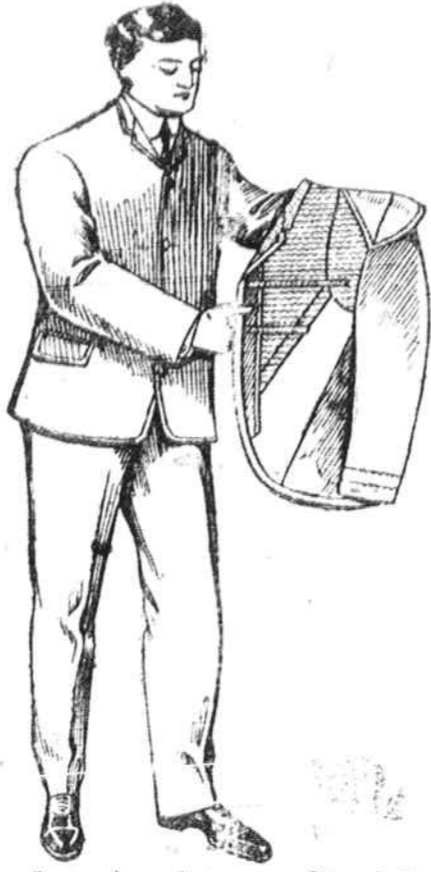
