To Burn A Million Bales.

Montgomery, Ala. Des. 10 .- A dozen merchants and farmers of Scottsboro propose to burn a milline bales of cotton so as to reduce the supply. They offer a provata share of fifty bales each for burning with planters in Alabama, Texas, Indian territory, Oklahoma, Mississtippi and Georgia. Farmers are organizing to haid the crop for ten ornte, and the same kind of movement to hold the crop is taking hold throughout the cotton growing states.

Twelve Cents for Cotton.

Hop Harrie Jordan of Monticel Ga., president of the Southern otton Growers' Protective associstion, issped an address to the cotno producers of the south in which ha says, smong other things:

"Let every holder of cotton abso lutely stop selling and sit down at home and quietly contemplate results. Let each holder determine to put no more cotton on the mar ket until prices advance and never sell a bale on a depresed market. "Let county meetings he held all over the belt and strong and active seps be taken to defend this most saluable agricultural product from speculator. Let every man who

still holds a bale of cotton in his possession join in these county or local meetings and agitate the importance of this stop among his neighbors to the end that success in the near future will be assured. We have held our own well so far, but we can do much better and easily advance the price from two to three coots by persistently refusing to sell and lightening up present 1ecelpts. Now let the price be fixed at 12 cente for the remainer of the crop and the world will accept it at that price malich will mean an addistant main of nearly \$50,000,000.
