These birds are striving day and night the whole year round to capture this food. How enormously val uable to man are the services of these hawks and owls has been pointed out many times by experts, who have studied their food. The man who kills a hawk or an owl, unless it be one of the three or four harmful spe community where he kills it. The woodpeckers spend all their time, winter and summer, searching for grubs which bore into the trees, and for the eggs of noxious insects which lie hidden in the crevices of the bark and the cracks of the dry wood; and that they devour is just so much help to the owner of the wood lot, because it reduces the number of his eni mies .- Ex.


