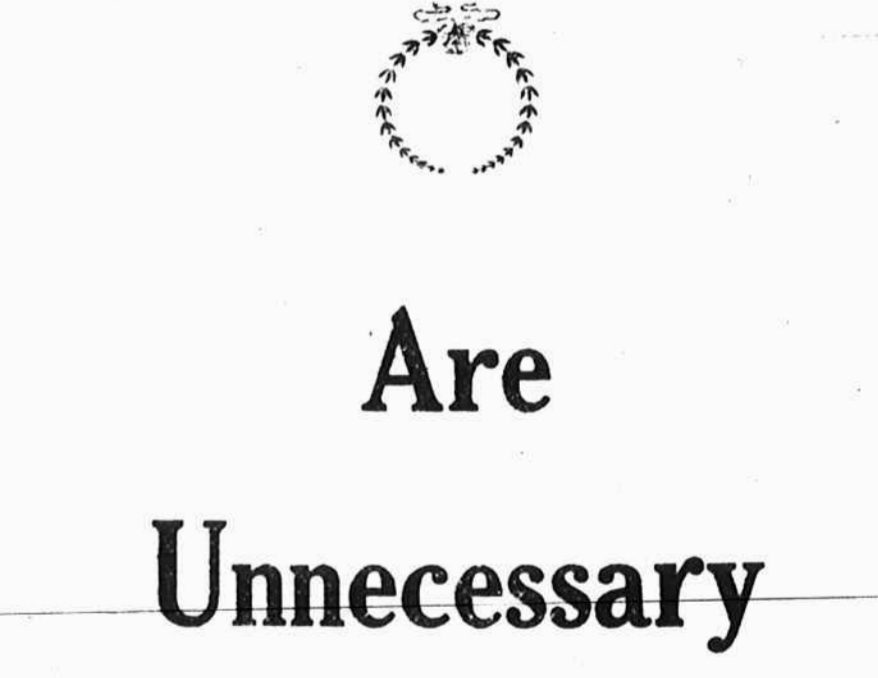
The injured follow: J. B. Timmermann, Kershaw; Henry Lamb, Ridgeland; Hector Logan, Brookland.
