It came from a British unit "in liaison." The chef was just getting ready to serve it when he noted that the bottles bore a German mark, and he informed the officer of the fact. That worthy forbade him to serve the champagne to the staff, and ordered him to throw the

"We did," says the chef, "but only the next morning they were empty."

Heavy fines and even jall sentences will be imposed on anyone dealing in exchange without having the payment of some foreign bill in view.

The Bulgarian leva before the warwas worth about the same as the French franc or about five to the American dollar. During the war the dollar at one time had a purchase value of 80 to 90 levas and now an American dollar is worth 125 levas.

All the big banks have expressed their desire to collaborate with the government in an effort to check the fall of the leva, but it seems that no remedy has yet been found.


