MADE BLOODY RECORD.

Two Hundred and Forty-Seven Persons Killed in State Last Year.

According to figures complied by Prof. Wilson Gee, of the University of South Carolings, 247 people were killed in homicides in South Carolina last year. The tables shows that Kershaw County had five homicides. Florence county leads with 16 killings to her credit, one man alone being responsible for the murder of five in one family, and is now under sentence of electrocution.

"Of all the countles in the state Dorchester county has the only, spotless record, there being not one single homicide in the county last year. Florence county had a total of 16 killings, Spartanburg had 11. Charleston and Bamberg 13 each, Anderson 12, and so on down the list.

"The relative rank of the countles. population considered, is shown in the following table compiled from the records of the Jureau of vital statistics." '. The first column shows number of homicides per county and the second column shows the percentage in each 1000.000 population :

The witnesses called as aforesaid shall be examined by the Mayor, under oath or affirmation, touching the nature of the business of such party ; and everything which may evince the amount of license tax for which such party shall be liable.
