**Corn Smut. How Beautiful.**

Clamson College, August 7.—Corn smut, which is beginning to make its appearance in this year's crop, is characterized by various sized swellings on almost any part of the plant above ground. At first these are white, but later they turn black, and still later they become dry and burst open. The interior is then filled with a dark brown or black powder, composed of the spores of the fungus. The damage is usually comparatively small as compared with some other sources of loss, but it is serious because it always occurs.

No satisfactory control measure is yet known. It is sometimes advised that the spore masses be destroyed but this measure is not apt to be very successful unless it be made a community practice over a considerable area and be persisted in for some years, since the fungus can maintain itself in the soil and in debris for a good while, just how long is not known. The Bureau of Plant Industry of the U. S. Department of Agriculture is working on the problem of control, and there are hopes that the investigation will solve the problem.

Corn smut does not seem to be poisonous to livestock. In fact, a possible utilization of it as human food has been suggested. Dr. F. L. Stevens, of the University of Illinois, a national authority on plant diseases, has tested it out and reported it delicious. The smut balls should be taken before they become dark and should be cooked like mushrooms.
