

Twenty-Five Farmers County Entered State Corn Cote

Twenty-five Kershaw county farmers have entered the Carolina Corn Improvement contest for 1949 to date, Agent W. C. McCarley announced this week. At the time he reminded farmers of the county that entries for the contest are available at his office. While date for signing the blanks is July 1, he urges who plan to enroll to do so at once.

Exam For Lugoff Rural Carrier

The United States Civil Service Commission has announced that an examination to fill the position of rural carrier at Lugoff will be held in Camden. Receipt of applications will close on June 23 and the date of examination will be stated on admission cards mailed to applicants after the closing date of receipt for applications.

Kershaw Ass'n. B. T. U. Meeting

The Kershaw associational Baptist Training Union quarterly meeting will be held with the Waterce Baptist church Friday evening, June 3 at 8 o'clock. All churches with training unions and those not organized yet are asked to send large delegations.

Tests should also enroll in the state contest, he adds. He points out that cash prizes totalling \$1,750 have been made available for the state contest by donations from members of the fertilizer industry in this state. The first prize for the largest yield of corn on one acre in the state will be \$600 with a second state prize of \$250. The prizes in each of the three extension districts will be \$200 for the largest one-acre yield in the district with a \$100 prize for the second largest yield in each.

"A contestant may enter not more than two one-acre plots, one of which will be considered for a prize," Mr. McCarley explains. "He may plant any variety of hybrid he chooses and may fertilize and cultivate as he thinks best. He will be expected to keep a record on his contest acre to be submitted to the Clemson Extension Service at the close of the contest. The official yield for the plot will be the calculated yield as determined by measurements, ear counts, weights, and moisture tests as made by the Extension Service. Complete details of the contest are given in the official rules and regulations available at the county agent's office," he concludes.

Springs Park To Open Saturday

Camden people have been invited to attend the opening of the Springs recreation park, operated for the employees of The Springs Cotton Mills and their friends, at 11 a. m., Saturday, June 4. Opening day will be featured by a series of programs by national and sectional radio entertainers, two big barbecues, the preliminary round of the Springmaid contest for 1949, the first trip on the miniature railway, the first ride on the merry-go-round, and the first roller skaters to fall down and go boom.

John Reed King will broadcast his famous Give and Take program on a national coast to coast hook-up over the Columbia Broadcasting system. If the weather is favorable, the broadcast will take place from the amphitheatre. If rains threaten, it will originate in the pavilion. The actual broadcast is from 12:30 until 1 o'clock, but John Reed King will begin picking the contestants from the audience at 12 o'clock and spectators should be in their seats before that time.

Following this will be a barbecue and tickets will be on sale at each mill cafeteria for 75 cents each. All people expecting to attend should purchase tickets in advance so enough food can be provided without wastage. Also the same barbecue tickets will have a stub and these stubs will be placed in a barrel and the contestants for the Give and Take program will be chosen by lot from this barrel.

Following the barbecue, John Reed King will continue his radio show from 2:30 until 4:30 in the amphitheatre.

Grady Cole and his Briarhoppers will broadcast from 4:30 until 5 o'clock over station WBT.

Following Grady Cole and the Briarhoppers will be the preliminaries for the Springmaid contest, when approximately 75 beauties from the Lancaster plant will compete and five will be chosen for the finals to be held in August.

Elliott Springs will act as master of ceremonies alternately with John Reed King and Grady Cole.
